vv. 1-2 I. The Retaliation

v.1 There was excitement in the air concerning this mountain top contest on Carmel! For some unknown reason, wicked and mean Jezebel didn't attend. There is no doubt that King Ahab was dreading the fact that he had to tell Jezebel that her god had been exposed as a sham.
